



## AUDIOLOGIST (1 FTE POSITION)

KOHealth is looking for a flexible and dynamic audiologist to join the interprofessional Jordan's Principle team.

### **Primary duties:**

Responsible for the assessment, audiological intervention, consultation, case coordination and management services for children from birth to 18 in KO communities. This position reports to the KO Health Director.

- Conduct hearing screenings and assessments
- Implementation of appropriate audiological intervention and follow-up
- Develop care plans for audiological (re)habilitation and implement plan in collaboration with speech-language pathologist(s) and other KO and community workers
- Provide case coordination services collaborating with other KOHealth and community Jordan's Principle staff
- Provide consultation to schools/pre-schools/other community centres regarding educational audiological recommendations
- Collaborate with other health professionals to develop population-based and preventative health programs
- Advise Health Director regarding audiological service delivery and work within supervision provided
- Identify gaps in community health services and develop proposals to address these gaps

- Current registration in good standing with the College of Audiologists and Speech-Language Pathologists of Ontario
- Master of Science in Audiology
- Sensitive to the cultural traditions of the Keewaytinook Okimakanak people
- Experience with paediatric and educational audiology
- Ability to develop and manage program
- Accountable and dedicated to serving underserved populations
- Willingness to travel by air frequently
