RIH offers high-level, specialty medical care including core physician specialties, emergency and trauma services, ambulatory and outpatient clinics, and diagnostic services. The Speech-Language Pathology Department provides services to the acute care units, the stroke unit, tertiary rehabilitation, outpatient rehabilitation and supports rural sites.

We are seeking a Speech-Language Pathologist to provide assessment and treatment of swallowing and communication disorders. In this role, the Speech-Language Pathologist is an autonomous professional who has expertise in typical development and disorders of communication as well as assessment and intervention in these areas. The Speech-Language Pathologist will work directly with clients, family and other professionals to create environments that promote optimal communication. The role offers collaboration with a small team of Speech-Language Pathologists who work at RIH including a Professional Practice Leader Speech-Language Pathologist who oversees the team.

Days of work are Monday to Friday with weekends and statutory holidays off. Travel may be required. This position is eligible for our comprehensive benefits plan that includes coverage for basic Medical Services, Dental Services, and Extended Health.

Interior Health (IH) offers a positive and supportive work environment that promotes continuous learning, professional growth, and clinical skill development.
