Speech and Language Pathologist

Successful applicants will:

- Have training at the Master's Degree level and experience as a Speech/Language Pathologist.
- be registered with CSHBC;
- be able to provide assessment, remediation and consultative help for children with disorders in communication;
- be able to provide programs and services for children with a wide range of communication disorders (voice, language, articulation/phonology, fluency) and augmentative/alternative communication needs;
- be able to work with a wide variety of support professionals
- be prepared to assist school based teams to develop appropriate IEPs
- be prepared to use technology (e.g.: computers, voice-mail, e-mail, web sites, MyEd BC) for planning, attendance monitoring, communication, and reporting purposes
- be prepared to support the school and district goals.

Preference will be given to those applicants who:

- have experience working collaboratively in classrooms with teachers to develop classroom plans for students with speech language concerns;
- have experience providing liaison with programs offered by external agencies;
- have experience providing liaison between home and school for children in need of social, emotional and behavioural support;
